<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Sam Goldbloom was born 31 December 1919. He began his working life at 16 years of age in the clothing trade. He then joined the Commonwealth aircraft factory as a sheet metal worker where he became a shop steward for his union. In 1941 he enlisted in the Australian Air Force as a flight mechanic. The following year he married Rosa Segal. Post war he was active in the Jewish Council to Combat Fascism and Anti-Semitism and the Australian Labor Party, standing for the party in municipal council and State parliamentary elections. As international tensions of the Cold War grew Sam Goldbloom devoted himself increasingly to working in the interest of world peace. He became active in the Victorian Peace Council. He was a founding member of the Congress for International Cooperation and Disarmament becoming its first secretary and later president. He was Australian representative on, and executive member of, the World Peace Council. He remained active in the peace movement throughout his life. In 1990 he was awarded the Order of Australia for his peace activism. He died 25 May 1999.</p>
