Index to Victorian Parliamentary papers P.p. 1/1992/93+

This index closely follows the model of the "Votes and Proceedings of the Victorian Legislative Assembly", produced by the Victorian Parliament. The Baillieu receives a free copy of all material tabled as a parliamentary paper in the Victorian Parliament and all these items are held on the Third Floor of the Baillieu at S 328.9451. There may also be a second copy for Loan or in a branch library, for which you should check on the computer catalogue. Earlier material is bound according to session.

NOTES: as this is a very specialized index it is possible to make certain omissions from the main entry, such as the word "Victoria". However, when looking in a card or computer catalogue always add the word "VICTORIA" to a govt. department i.e. look up:

Victoria. Adult Parole Board
Victoria. Auditor-General etc.

Preface parliamentary committees with the words VICTORIA and Parliament i.e. look up:

Victoria. Parliament. Legal and Constitutional Committee
Victoria. Parliament. Public Bodies Review Committee etc.

If you were looking up the title "Dying with dignity" the full entry is
VICTORIA. Parliament. Social Development Committee
Dying with dignity

However, on the computer catalogue "CATALYST" it is possible to make a shorter search viz.:

Select "5" All Categories, then type "Victoria dying with dignity" and press the "Keyword" button, NOT "Browse".

Changes to Victorian Parliamentary Papers

One point worth noting is that, "from the Spring Session of Parliament the number of Vicn. Parlt. Papers ordered to be printed... will be greatly reduced. This follows from the acceptance by Parliament of the recommendations of the Joint Report of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly Printing C'ttees, May 1989.
