This documentary discusses the 21st century resurgence of anti-Semitism worldwide, as is evident from hate-propaganda to vandalism, to attacks on Jews themselves. There, the annual average number of such incidents has more than doubled since the 1990s. A comparison of birth issues in outback Australia and arctic Canada. Considers the implications of the evacuation policy, whereby expectant mothers are taken on a long trip to a large hospital for an impending birth, far from home and where their first language is not spoken. Shows that while the majority of Aboriginal women comply with the evacuation policy, many feel that the practice is undermining indigenous traditions and culture. This practice is at odds with the very system which aspires to help the new mothers and their babies by

providing a high level of obstetric care. Distressed, the women often avoid the medical system, by hiding their pregnancy and presenting themselves at the clinics, in an advanced stage of labour. That way, they will not be sent away. In contrast, Inuit women in remote Northern Canada have stopped being evacuated for births because they now have a remote birth centre in their small town. Indigenous midwives have been trained locally, and they provide the benefits of both western medicine and their own culture.

Part one discusses the extent to which Australia should be staking on burying its fossil fuel power plant waste deep underground. The impending climate catastrophe, which is facing Australia, provides the impetus for an escape plan to save the country in time. Examines the proposed radical solution of geosequestration. Through this technology, instead of pumping the CO<sub>2</sub> into the air, it will be captured in the power station as it is being produced, compressed into liquid CO<sub>2</sub>, piped to a suitable location, then injected deep underground in rock formations where it would remain trapped for thousands of years. But, there are questions as to whether the idea will work, and do so in time, i.e. by the year 2050. For now, Australian scientists are still researching into the technology, its economics and long-term workability.

Part two looks at a very rare prehistoric insect, the tusk weta, a handful of which was found on Middle Island, N.Z., about 6 years ago. As the small colony was in danger of extinction, the N.Z. Dept. of Conservation launched an urgent rescue mission. This involved tracking down the few remaining insects, and relocating them to a new home free from predators. Includes footage of the tracking of these insects in their habitats; the successful breeding programme; and subsequent release of 50 tusk wetas in a new location, Red Mercury Island, a near neighbour of their original home. They were monitored with the help of high-tech micro transmitter backpacks fitted to individuals. The success of this breeding and relocation programme could ensure the survival of these giant wetas for years to come.

A report on violence against women in Guatemala, in recent years. Decades of civil war had left the country awash with guns and drugs. As more women leave home for school and work, they have become targets. At least two women are being murdered, per day. There exists a culture of violence, where women are the prey, attacks have become accepted, and even common place. Their murderers know they will never be caught, because most murders are never investigated and no one is charged. University students, Claudina and Titina, and school-girl, Stephanie were amongst more than 1,500 Guatemalan women, who have been murdered in the

last four years. The police and homicide department seem indifferent to, uninterested in, the alarming figures, claiming that such killings were crimes of passion, or that the victims were in gangs involved in organised crimes. The growing number of women murdered is due to impunity and inefficiency. Includes interviews with families of the murdered women in this report; and with Norma Cruz, human rights activist who helps such families seek justice.

Though scholars have rejected the contents of the book as facts, it is the most popular history book of recent years, selling over a

million copies. In Australia, its readers have taken sides in the history debate. Gavin Menzies has lectured at Melbourne University and is invited to attend conferences around the world.

'RFK' is a two-part biography of Robert F. Kennedy. Looks at his personal world, his role within the family, his involvement with Marilyn Monroe, and his grief and guilt following his older brother's assassination. Examines also Kennedy's complex relationships with some of the leading figures of his day, such as Martin Luther King and Lyndon B. Johnson. Interweaves selected archival footage with extensive interviews with family members, friends, journalists, his biographers, and Congress insiders, amongst many to present this film on RFK's life.

Part one is about him as a youngster growing up in the Kennedy family of nine children, under the critical eyes of an ambitious father, hungry for social status. Shows his role within the Kennedy family, its influence on him and his future career. In 1952, Bobby was campaign manager in Jack's successful bid for the Senate. He then became protector and defender, earning a reputation for ruthlessness. As President Kennedy's new Attorney General, Robert Kennedy became his confidante. But, a thousand days into Kennedy's presidency, Robert Kennedy received news of the president's assassination. Chronicles RFK's central role in many of the major events of the 1960s, such as the Cuban Missile Crisis, the civil rights movement and the war in Vietnam, based on personal narratives of those who knew him.

Part two begins with archival footage of Robert in mourning at his brother's funeral. Shows how he turned to Greek tragedies to understand the chaos and suffering, enabling him to identify with the suffering of other Americans. For this he came to be seen as a man of the people. The film also recounts the politics of the day which propelled RFK into running for office, viz, President Johnson's claim to JFK's legacy and his consolidation of presidential power, together with the escalation of Johnson's war in Vietnam. He had the overwhelming support of African and Mexican Americans; and he was victorious in California. Gives footage of the celebrations in California, when Kennedy was fatally shot. Examines how this tragic event, less than five years after the death of JFK, sealed Robert Kennedy's place in U.S. history.
